## 2019-2020 Goal #1: Student Attendance

The Township of Franklin Public School District will reduce the district-wide percentage of students deemed "chronically absent" as defined by the NJDOE <u>by at least .5%</u>. The district will also target the number of students absent from school between six (6) and ten (10) days in efforts to reduce that percentage by a <u>target of 2%</u> and the number of students absent from school between eleven (11) and seventeen (17) days in efforts to reduce that percentage by a <u>target of 2%</u>.

## Goal Rationale/Baseline Data

• During the 2018-2019 school year, the district successfully reduced the number of student absences (6-17 days) by 5.9%. The District Leadership Committee has endorsed the continuation of focused efforts in the area of student attendance.

• The New Jersey Department of Education defines "chronically absenteeism" as students that were not present for ten (10%) percent or more of the days in session a school year. Additionally, beginning in 2018 (using 2016-2017 data), the NJ DOE began reporting school and district chronic absenteeism rates on the annual School Performance Reports.
