General Summer School Information (subject to change):

- *The tentative summer school schedule is July 5th to August 19th and will run four days per week from 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.*
 - *The summer school program will be for students currently in grades K-5 (Delsea will be providing a summer program for eligible incoming 7th graders)*
 - *Transportation will be provided (if needed)*
 - *The summer school program will focus on Math and Language Arts remedial skills but will also include related arts and social/emotional learning activities*
 - *The summer school program will be an in-person learning experience, however, live streaming will be provided for students with extenuating circumstances*
 - *Attendance at summer school will be expected, however, we fully understand that families make vacation plans in the summertime and we will be as flexible as possible*
 - *It is our hope to have an open-enrollment summer school program, however, non-IEP mandated seats may need to be limited based on enrollment and staff availability*
